

# Sugar dispenser



## General instructions

The sugar dispenser is delivered with:

- 1) condiment top cover (Slimm: cover only)
- 2) removable stainless steel anti-jam grid
- 3) drip tray with stainless steel grid
- 4) removable dispensing unit (with portion control = about 4 gr.)
- 5) removable sugar funnel w / tube
- 6) standard picture (custom picture available on volume)

## First steps

- 1) NEVER USE THE DISPENSER BUT IF COMPLETELY DRY
- 2) to put sugar, remove top cover, check anti-jam grid is present, pour sugar in dispenser
- 3) push 2 or 3 times on dispensing unit button to let sugar go through and verify flow
- 4) put top cover back; dispenser is ready to use

## Regular maintenance

- 1) empty and clean drip tray
- 2) refill when needed

## Once in a while

- 1) clean condiment top cover and dispenser with warm cloth, avoid dishwasher
- 2) if needed (sugar jams, no flow, etc), do thorough clean process (see below) and MAKE SURE TO RE-USE WHEN ALL PARTS ARE COMPLETELY DRY

## Removable parts

- 1) it is possible to remove front panel by removing screws located on both sides of dispenser
- 2) it is possible to remove funnel/tube kit by first doing step 1 and pull funnel out
- 3) it is possible to remove dispensing unit by removing 2 screws located in the back of dispenser
- 4) it is possible to remove anti-jam grid by removing 1 screw
- 5) it is possible to remove tube from the funnel if tube is broken (use a bit of water to put back)

## Thorough clean process

*(note: this process can last more than 24 hours, we recommend having a spare funnel/tube kit)*

- 1) remove front cover and clean with warm cloth
- 2) in a sink, use hot water and soft cleaner only (dishwashing soap)
- 3) remove funnel/tube, verify tube quality, clean in water
- 4) remove anti-jam grid, clean in water
- 5) you don't need removing the dispensing unit to clean it
- 6) clean the dispenser in water, let stuck sugar melt
- 7) LET DISPENSER AND PARTS COMPLETELY DRY (use air pump if available)
- 8) put back parts when dry
- 9) follow **First steps**
